Despite the spread of the COVID-19 in the region, our local partners have expressed a desire to continue serving the most vulnerable in their communities, especially when it comes to food distributions, which remain a vital necessity.

To help protect them, we are providing guidance, as well as basic personal protective equipment, including masks, bleach, pump sprays, alcohol, gloves, and hand sanitizer.

Through them, we also started providing vulnerable families with essential hygiene kits to meet their immediate sanitary needs. Each kit contains soap, hand sanitizer, and paper towels. The provision of hygiene kits will not only help prevent the spread of the coronavirus within densely populated refugee and vulnerable Lebanese settlements, it will also provide much-needed relief to vulnerable households in the middle of Lebanon's ongoing economic crisis.
