

FOOD ASSISTANCE : IMMEDIATE RELIEF

The first days following the explosion, we provided our church partners in Beirut with 7,800 ready meals to distribute in Beirut. As many of the blast-affected households were already struggling financially because of the economic crisis Lebanon is going through, we also distributed 2,200 multipurpose vouchers to help vulnerable blast-affected households stand back on their feet in these difficult days.
